NAME The Ward County Farm Bureau Lynn Martin Memorial Scholarship

PURPOSE: The scholarship will recognize academic achievements as well as leadership skills of high school seniors. Lynn Martin was active in Farm Bureau for 40 years both on the county and state level. Lynn was agriculture in North Dakota.

AMOUNT: A \$1000.00 scholarship will be given to one female and one male graduating senior.

CRITERIA: The applicant's parents or grandparents must be a member of North Dakota Farm Bureau. A membership can be obtained by contacting wcfarmbureau@srt.com. The cost of a membership is \$50.00.

Applicant must be a graduating senior this calendar year in the spring.

Applicant must be a well-rounded student who has achieved a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better. The student should maintain quality involvement in a balance of extracurricular activities and service activities. Student should also demonstrate leadership ability and potential.

Applicant must send application, high school transcript and three reference statements from individuals other than relatives no later than MAY 1, 2017. Forms are available online at www.ndfb.org/edusafe/scholarships.

Must be a resident of Ward County.
