Sponsor: The Traill County Farm Bureau will award four \$500 scholarships annually.

Purpose: These scholarships will recognize achievements in educational and community involvement in agriculture, as well as N.D Farm Bureau involvement.

Criteria: The following criteria will be used in selecting recipients. Applications must be completed on a typewriter or computer.

1. The scholarships will be awarded to high school senior students who are a resident of Traill County or parents holding a Traill County Farm Bureau membership, planning on majoring in agriculture related studies, in a college or technical school.
2. Applicants must have achieved a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better.
3. Preference will be given to applicants whose parents are involved in an ag-related industry and to students involved in ND Farm Bureau (i.e. attendance of the ND Farm Bureau Citizenship Seminar.)
4. Scholastic honors, goals and ambitions, and work experience will also be considerations.
5. Applications must be postmarked no later than **May 16, 2019**
